Software-Version 1.02 includes:

- New **Ring Mod “Dirt” type** which adds ring modulation from Osc1 & Osc2.
- Expanded **Pitch Details**: aside to pitch bend range you can now also put Osc 1 and/or Osc 2 to fixed pitch not reacting to notes.
- Startup firmware version display.
- Support for **MIDI Bank Select (LSB aka CC32)** across all 360 slots.
- **Bug fixes**.
